

What is Visual Literacy?


- the ability to interpret, negotiate, and make meaning from information presented in the form of an image

- find your unique answer to the problem




Use four black squares to create images that express the meaning of these six words...

☐ Order ☐ Increase ☐ Bold Congested ☐ Tension Playful


✓ The squares can vary in size




✓ The squares are solid black, but when they overlap each other you may distinguish this by using white space or lines




✓ OR! They can overlap with no visible separation.




✓ Think of where your squares are in relation to the page (composition)




✓ Think of where your squares are in relation to the page (composition)




✓ The squares can touch creating a larger shape that may lose the form of a square




✓ Be sure to try overlapping for some of these problems



✓ Contrast in size, position, direction, and space will drastically affect the meaning of your design




✓ Be aware of the relationship between positive (the black squares) and negative (the blank) space
